



The year Brooksville was established.

Nestled in the heart of Hernando County, just under an hour's drive north of the bustling city of Tampa, **Brooksville is a hidden gem along Florida's Nature Coast** offering a unique old-world charm. The region is known for its beautiful natural surroundings, with opportunities for hiking, biking, and wildlife observation in places like Withlacoochee State Forest. Additionally, you can explore the Weeki Wachee Springs State Park, known for its crystal-clear waters and live mermaid shows. CITRUS BELT

Brooksville is part of Florida's "Citrus Belt," which is an area known for its favorable climate and soil conditions for growing citrus fruits. The region's well-drained sandy soils makes it perfect for citrus tree growth. Citrus trees require good drainage to prevent root rot, a common issue in areas with heavy, waterlogged soils. The Citrus Belt experiences a prime harvest season during the fall and winter months, typically from November through March, when citrus fruits like oranges are at their peak of ripeness and flavor.


HISTORY OF BROOKSVILLE

Brooksville, Florida, originally known as Melendez, achieved its incorporation in 1856. Rich with history and old-world charm, this city boasts a varied topography with elevations spanning from 175 to 274 feet, adding to its beauty. The region has a rich heritage of accomplished planters, cultivators, and cattle ranchers within and in the vicinity of Brooksville.

CLIMATE

Brooksville enjoys warm temperatures during winter/spring (peak season), and mild summers compared to Southern Florida. Average temperatures fluctuate from the mid 60s in the winter months, to the 70s in spring and fall, and up into the high 80s during the summer.

KAROO

BOLD DESIGN. CREATIVE PLAY. ADVENTURE GOLF.

Karoo presents golfers with a labyrinth of fun yet challenging options. Architect Kyle Franz transformed a canvas of sandy soil into a dynamic 7,201-yard layout that features some of the world's widest Bermuda fairways, expansive greens, and bold contours that encourage creative play. Golfers will encounter Sandhill Cranes throughout their round, whose distinctive "karoo" bird calls echo through the landscape. One of the course's defining distinctions is its multi-route holes, offering two or even three distinct paths to the flagstick. Much like the Old Course at St Andrews, Karoo is a course of discovery, where local knowledge and experience are vital to navigating its complexities, making you want to play again and again to master its nuances. Every visit to Karoo offers a fresh perspective and a new challenge.



UNMISTAKABLE OLD-FLORIDA CHARM.

Roost transports golfers to the relaxed charm of Old Florida, where ancient live oaks frame approach shots with beauty and strategic shot-shaping. Named for the turkeys that roost under its 100-year-old trees, Roost sits beside farmland where cows graze under shady oaks, epitomizing bucolic bliss. Located on the rolling Brooksville Ridge with 80-foot elevation changes, Roost reflects Ben Cowan-Dewar's fascination with great collaborations, from Pine Valley's collective genius to the Traveling Wilburys. Co-designers Mike Nuzzo and Kyle Franz, with Ran Morrisett as Golf Course Architecture Advisor, partnered with Rod Whitman to craft greens that unify the course's serene, captivating 7,200-yard layout.



SQUEEZE

The Wedge is an 11-hole par-3 course that offers a unique, immersive experience as it weaves inside the dramatic landscape of The Squeeze, yet it stands out with its own set of bold features. 
